Nesci Estate was established in 1948 by Antonio and Carmelina Nesci, when they cleared the land by hand and planted the first grape vines. Today Nesci Estate Wine Farm now has over 60 acres of vineyards, and is also home to around 100 beef cattle. The Nesci tradition of producing fine table wines, ports and liqueurs has been continued by their son Kevin. Seasonality

Although you will have a great time in Chittering all year-round, springtime (August to November) is hands down, the best time of year to take on the Farm Flavour Trail

The valleys are green, our farms are full of fresh produce, and the countryside comes alive with wildflowers. Check the table below to see what's in season.

Stroll through walk trails full of flowering plants, or stop at a range of roadside stalls with fresh produce (ask at the Chittering Visitor Centre for some tips on where to find these).

Keep an eye out for regional events throughout this time as Chittering SpringFest hosts a range of events throughout September, and A Taste of Chittering; the regional celebration of fresh produce takes place at Nesci Estate in spring too.

Itineraries

SPRING FLING WEEKEND - 2 day trail (Aug-Nov)

Day 1

Whisk yourself away for a weekend in the Chittering Valley. If it's around spring you've come at the perfect time. Whether you're waking up at a farmstay or driving up in the morning start Day 1 with a short wildflower walk through **Djidi-Djidi Ridge**, before rewarding yourself with a platter, or pizza and a tasting of plonk from **Nesci Estate Wine Farm**. If you've got the time maybe get the know-how to grow-your-own produce at **Trive Sustainability** or **Muchea Tree Farm**. Make sure to book yourself in for a tractor tour at **The Orchard Perth** before rounding the day out with a generous dinner with award winning wines at **Stringybark Winery Restaurant**, before hitting the hay at one of Chittering's farmstays, like **Orchard Glory Farm Resort**.

Day 2

Grab a coffee and pastry at the famous **3** Bindoon Bakehaus and stock up on some produce supplies from the **3** Northern Valleys Locavore Store. Swing by the **7** Chittering Visitor Centre for award-winning olives and local knowledge, then pick yourself up some tasty mandarins from **3** Oversby's Citrus. Pop in to **9** Wootra Farm, a working asparagus farm with produce and preserves at the 'Asparavan', before heading to **1** Little Eeden Farm Apiary for a tasty lunch and honey tasting amongst the animals. Make sure to pick up fresh local avocadoes from **1** Avalon Farm before finishing at the final farm gate with hand-crafted cheese from **1** The Local Goat.

JUST A TASTE - For weekend day trippers (Aug-Nov)

Looking to jump in the car and get lost in the countryside for the day? This essentials trip will be just the ticket. Starting off with a pit stop for coffee and supplies at the **3** Bindoon Bakehaus and **6** Locavore Store. Get some prize-winning olives and all thinformation from the **7** Chittering Visitor Centre then onward to **9** Wootra Farm to check out the asparagus and the 'Asparavan'. Grab morning tea and/or essential delicious honey supplies from **10** Little Eeden Farm Apiary, walking it off with a short meander through the wildflowers at **2** Djidi-Djidi Ridge. Lunch and wine at **3** Stringybark Winery, or **1** Nesci Estate (or wine/beer at both?) Finish off the day with a fun fruit picking tour and tractor ride, after feeding the farm animals at **2** The Orchard Perth.

'OFF-SEASON' EXPLORER - December to July

"But it's not spring?" Chances are you're visit Chittering in the 'less-busy' times of year. That's great for you - you might have most of the place to yourself (in case there wasn't enough space out here already...). It might be a little less green but there's still a truckload of things to do.

All Weekend

If you're here for the weekend you can do most of the "SPRING FLING", just omit the seasonal stops 3, 9 and 1 (unless it's Mango Season - then definitely go to 1!)

Just A Taste - Weekend Day Trip

If you've only got a day to spare most of "JUST A TASTE" will work out perfectly for you. If you're in the mood for a drive the delicious cheese at

The Local Goat would be a worthy substitute for
Wootra Farm which will be closed outside of season.

MIDWEEK MISSION - Year round

Depending on what day you arrive here, Chittering still has some curiosities during the week. The **3** Bindoon Bakehaus will gladly fill that cake or lunch-shaped hole in your stomach. The **3** Locavore is open through the week with fresh, local produce. The **7** Visitor Centre can help you to find some interesting **3** walk trails, and if you're here Wednesday onwards, **3** Stringybark Winery is good for a sneaky midweek wine with lunch and **9** Wootra Farm is open the same days during season. If you're here on a Friday book an orchard and fruit-picking tour at **2** The Orchard Perth.
