Length & Estimated Time

800m trail, 1.6km / 30 minutes return.

Quality

Formed tracks, some small obstacles, the track has clearly identifiable markers.

Visitor Safety

Please stay on the track and remember that you are in a natural area, your safety is our concern but ultimately is your responsibility. Make sure you have suitable footwear, a hat, sunscreen and water.

Caring for the Trail

Do not feed the native animals as it interferes with their ability to hunt. Taking flora and fauna is prohibited but please do take your rubbish. Cleaning shoes/tyres to help prevent dieback spread would be appreciated.

Difficulty - "Class 2"

A formed natural surface trail with no signage but track is obvious.
